

## LECTIO

A song of ascents. Of David.

<sup>1</sup> My heart is not proud, LORD, my eyes are not haughty;

I do not concern myself with great matters or things too wonderful for me.

<sup>2</sup>But I have calmed and quieted myself, I am like a weaned child with its mother: like a weaned child I am content.


3 Israel, put your hope in the LORD both now and forevermore. (Psalm 131)

Choose a word, a phrase, or a picture that emerges from the passage. Meditate and be still in God's presence.

## HOPE

And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. (Romans 5:5)
