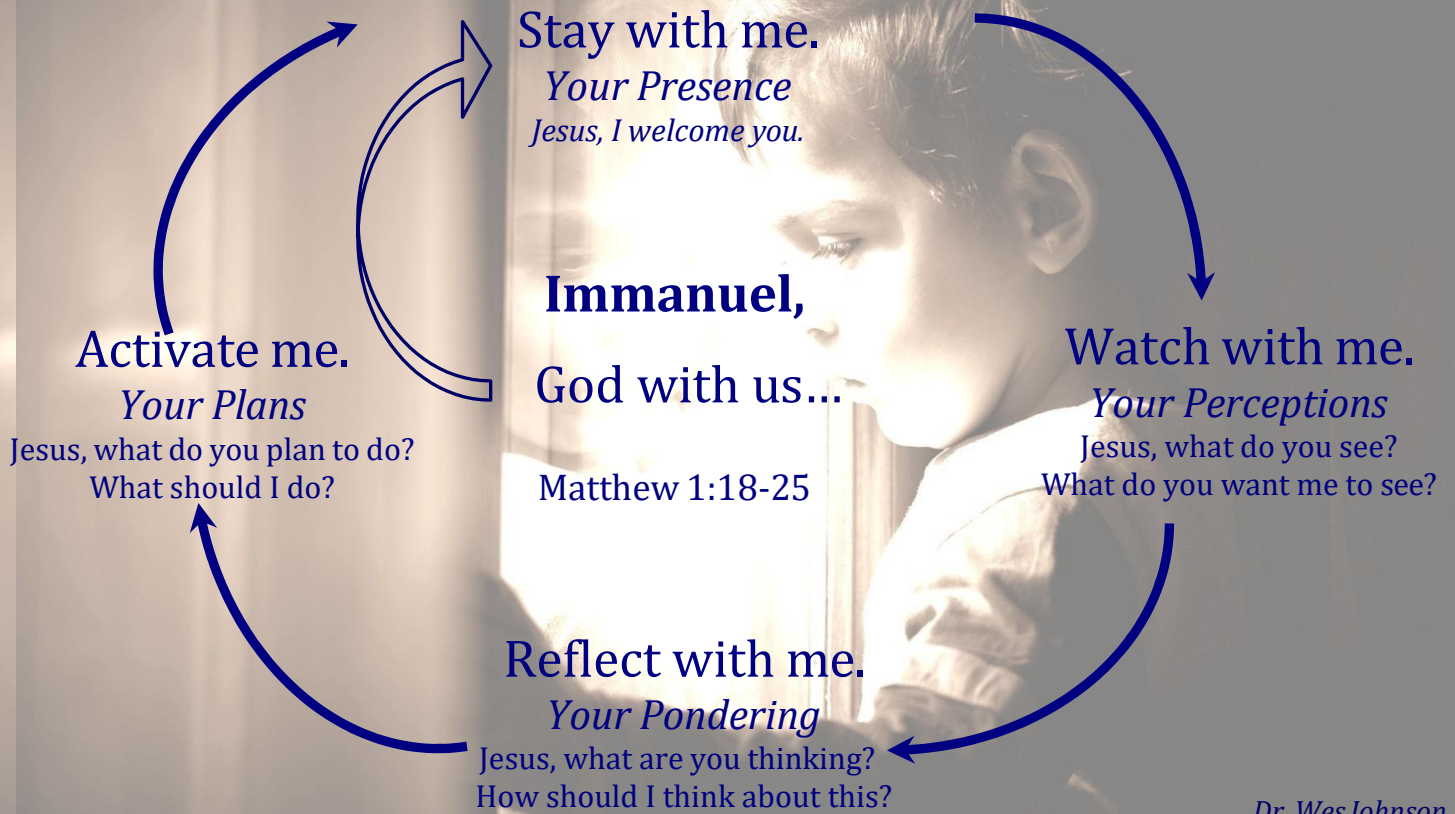

## *Moving from Consolation to Activation*
